Agenda Item #9 Consideration and action as needed on the Turnverein Restoration Project

Pat Burns: Paul Jones and Pat Burns went to a meeting with representatives from the city John Moore, and Joe Ed Lynn, and the representative of the Austin County Fair. It was a good meeting. We are set to vote on the Turnverein this meeting contingent on a lease agreement, but there is currently not a lease agreement. There are also the following concerns:

- 1. It's a lot of money
- 2. The air conditioning is a lot money
- 3. We possibly won't be able to rent it out any more than what it is currently being rented for.

We asked the Turnverein Committee to do or answer the following:

- 1. Are there options on the air conditioning?
- 2. Can we prioritize the needs?
- 3. Include air conditioning in the first phase.
- 4. Tell the EDC exactly what each element will cost.
- 5. Can we do this in stages?
- 6. List of possible grants and amounts, and what are the requirements?

The Austin County Fair (ACF) is very interested in managing the building.

Look at the positives:

- 1. Work toward the goal of making the fairgrounds an event center.
- 2. The ACF grounds are owned by many entities, but would benefit from being managed by the ACF

Board Member	Questions and Comments
Paul Jones	We have brought in a new stake holder than be a true positive stake holder. The ACF does get calls t rent the Turnverein. The Turnverein Committee does not want to manage the building. The lease ca be worked out by all involved. Everyone agreed that it is a good thing for the community.
Pat Burns	The lease needs to be modified. There is no need currently for a lease as we can fund a performance agreement. He will send the agreement back to Jeff Moore. The proposal as it stands now will come back to the EDC next month.
Annye King	The current proposal will pay for plans to get bids from builders.
Paul Jones	The state tax credit program will pay 20% of the cost and that is huge.
Reesa Ueckert	Have we received everything that we will get for the \$20,000.00 – Pat - yes
Danny Jacob	Waiting to see what the Turnverein Committee can come up with funds wise? City has neglected this building for 20 years. We have not seen a business plan, we have not seen the economic developmen that this project will bring.
Annye King	Weddings are going to halls outside of Bellville. If our building was in good condition with air conditioning they could have their weddings there. There are challenges to keeping the integrity of the building.
Pat Burns	When we finally get the final numbers, we might not be able to do it. Will talk to Jeff Moore about getting a performance contract.
Garrett Dornon	If the EDC does not come up with the money will this project be dead? Annye- We are talking to several including LCRA and other foundations asking for money. We were having a party on May 11 th , but it is on the back burner. We don't feel comfortable having a fund raiser until we are for sure the project will move forward. We have to do it historically correct.
Danny Jacob	There is not one person in Bellville that does not want the Turnverein preserved

Reesa Ueckert	Had been asked the question of why the previous EDC board was willing to spend \$800,000.00 plus on the Bishop Pavilion and sidewalk but were so reluctant to spend money on the Turnverein, and would like to have an answer for this person. Pat Burns responded that it was a good project and that he would do it again even though in the planning it could not prove economic impact. Paul Jones stated he would again vote for the project and voted for it because it was part of the Texas A and M master plan, and Danny Jacob does not regret his vote on the project.
