Working with City and TxDOT about traffic signal at Highway 36 due to new developments

September, 2023 Traffic Signal Upgrade for radar detection at Newman Bakery. Contractor is waiting on supplies and safety issues are being addressed.

September, 2023 New Traffic Signal at Highway 36 and FM 2429. New and improved entrance to TLD Ramp

Proposed Electrical Improvements to City Parking Lot and Bishop Pavilion (4th Qtr, 2023)

Continuing to work with City in regards to work schedule for Alley Capital Improvement Projects Utility Upgrades – 3rd Qtr, 2023

TLD Ramp continues to progress in opening to full capacity its major operations facility in Bellville. TLD Ramp are finalizing plans to double the size of the current site in Bellville and an improved and safer entrance. In addition, TLD Ramp has a possible 3 more companies moving to the Bellville area.
